

VetPrac Medical Plus Award in Diagnostic Imaging

Win a \$2500 surgical training
voucher and \$500 cash prize



Eligibility

The prize may be awarded to a student in their 5th year of the BVSc program. To be considered for this award, the student must either:

A Submit an essay between 700 and 2,500 words examining an experience in EMS where diagnostic imaging (ideally ultrasound) is or could be used to assist in diagnosis and treatment of a case. Applicants will draw on the practical learning gained from the case or review that builds on theory from university lectures.

OR

B Drawing on experience in clinical practice rotations write an article between 700 and 2,500 words on "The benefits versus disadvantages of different modalities of diagnostic imaging and their various roles in general clinical practice"

Selection of Candidate

A panel of staff members from the School of Veterinary Science and VetPrac shall select the winner. If there is no candidate of sufficient merit then the prize may not be awarded.
